WANTED FOR THEORY OF RELATIVITY

PART 1-WANTED POSTER-100 pts

Requirements:

1. Poster **MUST** be on an 8 1/2 x 11 poster board or construction paper. **5 points**
2. Poster **MUST** be neat, use correct spelling, punctuation and easy to understand. **5 points**
3. Mug shot - We need to know what they look like! **10 points**
4. First, Middle and Last name of your scientist. **5 points**
5. Birth Date and Year of Death or if still alive. **5 points**
6. What country were they born in and where did they do their work? **10 points**
7. What are they famous (wanted) for? **5-8 bullet point phrases in your own words. 30 points**
8. A fact that you found interesting OR a quote by that person. **10 points**
9. Make a photocopy of your sources with information highlighted. **15 points**
10. Your name on the bottom right corner. **5 points**

PART 2-TIMELINE-

Personal/Historical Timeline Assignment

For this assignment you will specifically be focusing on your scientist and what has occurred during their lifetime. Create a timeline in which you find historical and personal events that have taken place regarding your scientist. Starting off with their birth, map out **7 meaningful events of their life**. Then on the opposite side of the timeline, list out 5 other events that occurred during their lifetime. They can be historical or technological. Then, next to each item on the timeline add a visual that represents the event. This can be a drawing, a photo, or a printed picture.

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**Remember this is a timeline so you should start with their birth, so it is not counted as one of the events*

Each personal event and each historical event listed will be worth 5 points (60 points total). This assignment is taking the place of a unit test. Be sure to provide all required information in order to receive full credit.

PART 3 **Gallery of Astronomers Walk** **40 Points**

Timeline for project

- Research Scientist, use the library, internet, books, etc. on your Scientist. Take notes and pull information on what they look like (mug shot), etc.
- Develop Wanted Poster with the information you have gathered. Remember a “mug shot” is needed!
